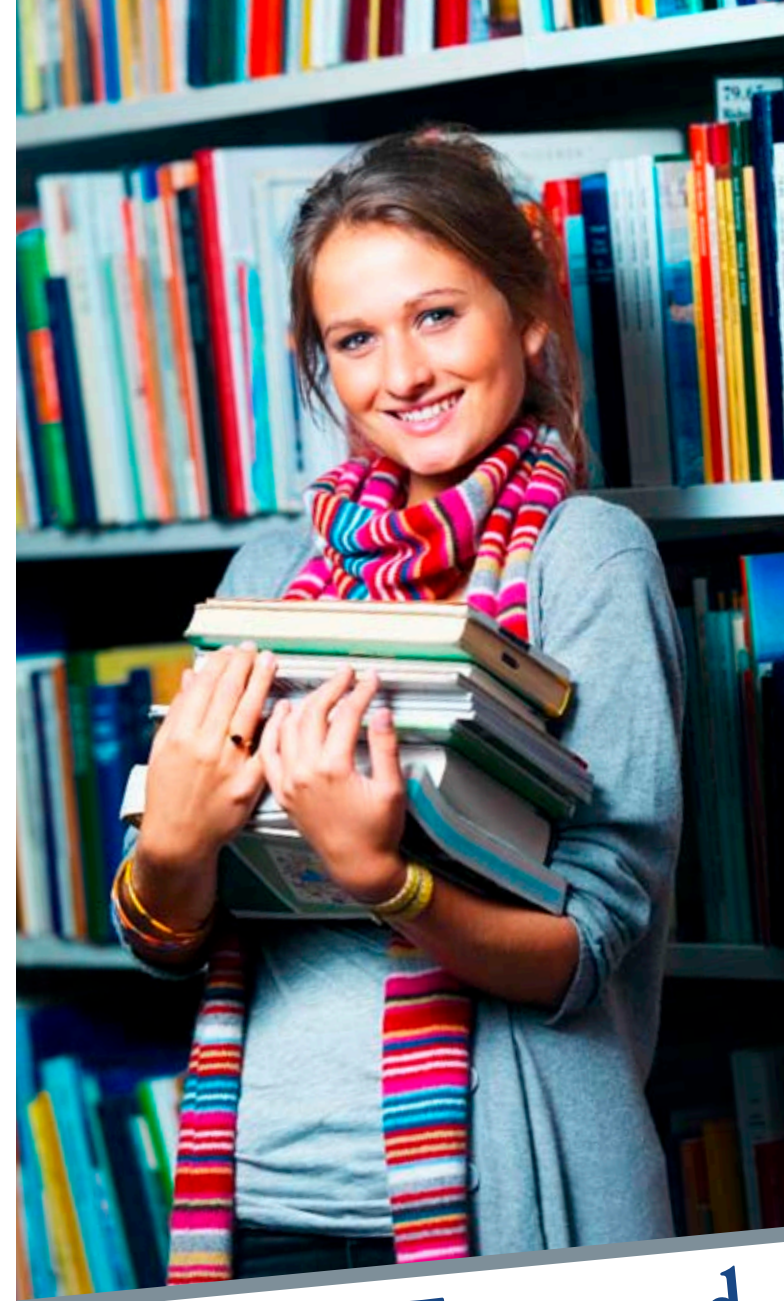

KATE: The online library catalog is used to find books, videos, music, manuscripts, and multimedia items owned by Limestone.

Borrowing Material: The Student Identification Card serves as the library card (LCard). Students must present the ID card to check out library material. Extended Campus students may call or email the library for delivery of books. Material will be mailed to the student's home address along with a prepaid label so that items can be returned at no cost to the student.

PASCAL Delivers: A rapid book-delivery service provided by South Carolina's virtual academic library. PASCAL Delivers enables students and faculty at South Carolina's institutions of higher learning to request books from over 40 academic libraries in the state with the click of a mouse. Research Databases: Online databases provide a way to search for scholarly full-text articles, magazine and newspaper articles, books, citations, music, and more. The Limestone College Library subscribes to a number of specialized databases for various subjects. <http://www.limestone.edu/research-databases>

Electronic Journals: Used to search for a specific journal or magazine title, the electronic journals are also categorized by subject area. Electronic Journals can be found by selecting the "Find Journals" tab from the library's home page.

LibGuides: Research Guides are provided for subject areas and/or a specific class. These guides provide things such as recommended reference titles, journals (both online & print), and which research databases to use. LibGuides are very much a work in progress and are constantly being updated.
